## (RESTRICTED ROADS & 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2012

The Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and 84(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. The County of Cambridgeshire (Restricted Roads and 30 mph speed limit) (No.1) Order 2005 is hereby revoked.
- 2. The roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on any of the roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the "Cambridgeshire County Council (Restricted Roads & 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on the 9th day of November 2012.
