FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 0545/2014

In reply to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, received in the constabulary on 17th July as follows:

this is an FOI request for the speed camera statistics for the last three years in the village of Barton, Cambridgeshire.

I require the figures for each month in the last three years separate and speeds under 30-35mph, under 36-45mph and 46mph+

The monthly divide is prerequisite to the speeds but if you can give those also that would be very helpful.

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 (The Act) requires us to handle all requests in a manner that is blind to the identity of the requestor. Any information released in response to a request is regarded as being published, and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

We have completed all searches within Cambridgeshire Constabulary and hereby enclose your response.

The constabulary do not currently record vehicles travelling between 30-35 MPH as Cambridgeshire Police follow ACPO guidelines. Cameras will register vehicles travelling in excess of 36 MPH which is the reason the first column contains no data.

Active enforcement has been possible since April this year and the figures reflect that.
